Day By Day Itinerary

Day 1 — Baku Arrival

- **Arrival in Baku:**

 - Explore **Tufandag**, a renowned tourism complex offering activities for every season. You can take a cable car ride or enjoy skiing on the different tracks. The complex also offers facilities such as a ski school, entertainment centers for kids, and a restaurant to unwind after your adventures.
- **Nohur Lake:**
 - Visit **Nohur Lake**, a picturesque lake located in the mountains of Gabala. Enjoy a peaceful walk by the water or take some beautiful photographs with the backdrop of green hills.
- **Return to Baku:**
